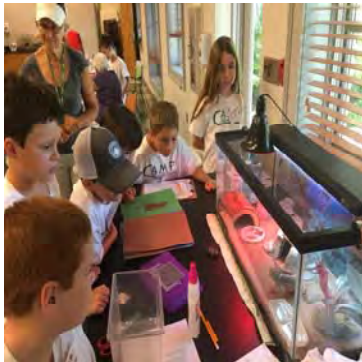

# Frequently Asked Questions

- ◆ **What grade do I sign my child up for?**  
*You must sign your child up for the grade they will be entering in the 2017-2018 school year.*
- ◆ **How many weeks can I sign up for?**  
*Since we have a different theme offered each week, campers of the same age group can sign up for up to two weeks.*
- ◆ **What will the campers do all day?**  
*Campers will do tons of fun activities including touring the zoo and gardens, close up animal encounters, special arts and crafts projects with a certified art teacher, games, and experiments. A detailed list of activities will be given the first day of camp.*
- ◆ **What is the camper to adult ratio?**  
*There are approximately 15 students per camp group. Each group will have one instructor and two volunteers. Each instructor and volunteer is background-checked, and our instructors are CPR/ First Aid Certified.*
- ◆ **Can my third grader and fourth grader attend the same class?**  
*No, for the benefit of the classes and the campers, we strictly adhere to our grade guidelines.*
- ◆ **What should my camper bring to camp?**  
*Campers should wear closed-toed shoes, clothes they don't mind getting a little dirty, a water bottle, and a lunch every day of camp. Sunscreen and bug spray are helpful as we do spend a lot of time outdoors. A snack will be provided for the campers at 2:30pm.*
