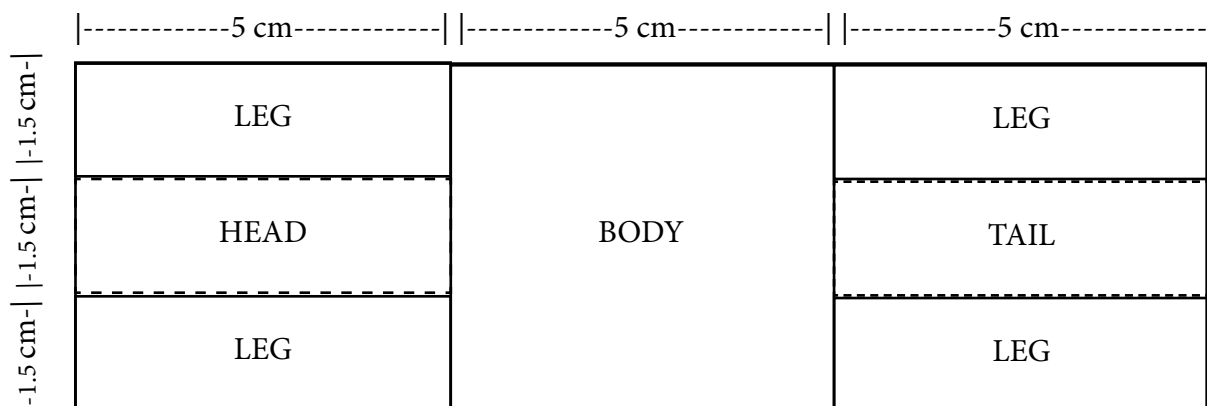


Can you make a paper horse that walks?



Use the template above to draw out your plan for your horse.

Cut along the dotted lines and fold along the solid lines.

Curl the tail up so it is out of the way of the legs.

Fold the neck of the horse up and form a head at the end, as seen in the picture.

Cut the bottom for the legs at a very slight angle. You may need to round them a little, so it rocks like a rocking chair. The highest point being at the outside edge.

Make an incline using a stack of books and a flat surface, or whatever is available to you at home.

Position your horse at the top of the incline and give it a slight nudge to get it started. Blowing on it softly, also helps.
