



Brookgreen Gardens Unveils New Exhibit for Spanish Goats

MURRELLS INLET, S.C., October 18, 2021 - [Brookgreen Gardens](#), a conservator of the Lowcountry's indigenous wildlife and historically significant domestic animals, has opened a new Spanish goat exhibit in Brookgreen's Floyd Family Heritage Farm. Unveiled Oct. 16 at a ribbon cutting ceremony, the new habitat contains a grazing area and barn to continue preserving and exhibiting this heritage breed.

"We are so excited to unveil this new exhibit during our 90th anniversary celebration," says Page Kiniry, president and CEO of Brookgreen Gardens. "Preserving and exhibiting animals native to the Lowcountry is a mission that was set by our founders, Archer and Anna Hyatt Huntington. We are proud to continue building on their legacy by expanding our educational attractions."

Since 2011, in collaboration with the Spanish Goat Conservation Society, Brookgreen has been breeding the Lowcountry Spanish goat bloodline. The program helps to sustain this rare breed, increasing diversity and educating the public about the important role of domestic animals in the state's history. This new exhibit will enhance Brookgreen's ability to support the program and improve visitors' experiences interacting with these animals.
